

Admission Policy

33 Liceum im. M. Kopernika, Warszawa

The admission to the Middle Years Programme and the IB Diploma Programme in 33 Liceum im. M. Kopernika are regulated by the School Statutes (Statut XXXIII Liceum Ogólnokształcącego Dwujęzycznego im. Mikołaja Kopernika z siedzibą w Warszawie przy ul. Józefa Bema 76).

IB MYP Admission

The students are accepted to the MYP 4 (year 1 of secondary school in the national system) according to the national requirements updated annually by the Ministry of Education and based on the national legal policies regulating acceptance of students to state schools. In addition, the Electronic system of recruitment to state schools is used in Warsaw.

Admission is open to primary school students and it is based on the end-of-school certificate results and the positive results from the English language Competence Test (usually a result of 60% or more is required).

The admission of candidates willing to transfer to IB MYP programme during the school year (in case of free places) will be based on their results and abilities. As Polish and English are both languages of instruction, we expect potential students to be able to continue the courses due. We also give students possibility to make up their lacks in mutually established period of time.

IB DP Admission

According to the Statutes, the School Head appoints the IB DP Admissions Committee consisting of IB DP Coordinator as chair, IB pre-DP and MYP homeroom teachers, and a number of other teachers from among IB DP faculty.

Admission is open to all IB pre-DP and MYP students, and (in case of free places) to students from bilingual classes of 33 Liceum im. M. Kopernika, and candidates from outside the school.

Admission is based on the end-of-year certificate results obtained in the year preceding the Programme:

- students currently enrolled in our IB pre-DP, MYP, and bilingual classes will have obtained at least grade 4 out of 6 in English and each subject they intend to study at higher level, their total attendance rate will be minimum 85%; they will also be approved by the Admissions Committee; the Committee may base their approval on an interview with the candidate,
- candidates from outside 33 Liceum will have obtained at least grade 5 out of 6 (or equivalent if from Polish educational system) in English and each subject they intend to study at higher level, their total attendance rate will be minimum 85%; they will also be approved by the Admissions Committee following an interview with the candidate,

- special needs candidates will be admitted based on the approval of the Admissions Committee following an interview with the candidate.
